



UPDATE ON DJCS REOPENING PLAN

12+ Vaccination Letter

December 13, 2021

Dear Parents of Students 12 years of age and older,

We're looking forward to returning to in-person learning on site at the MNJCC in January!

In keeping with the Jewish values of SHMIRAT HA-GUF (protecting the health of our bodies) and PIKUACH NEFESH (saving a life), our priority is to ensure the health and safety of all our students and staff. Having sought the guidance of both health and legal professionals, and in keeping with public health guidelines and MNJCC policies, all students over 12 years of age must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 at least 14 days prior to entry with a vaccine approved by Health Canada. Students will be required to show proof of vaccination and identification at the door in order to enter the building. (If your child does not have their own ID, a parent may show their ID.) Students turning 12 will have three months from the time of their birthday to get double-vaccinated.

After the first entry, a cohort group listing will be created so that this proof will not be required on subsequent visits to the building. Students will continue to be screened upon entering the building and masks are required on site.

Please discuss these requirements with your children so that they arrive at our first classes in January prepared with all necessary documents.
